From the Pastor's Pencil

About 14 years ago, when Laurie and I moved from Pembroke Pines, Florida, to Palm Beach Gardens, a little farther up the Atlantic coast, we began looking for a new church family. Laurie's parents, who had been members of a Disciples congregation for several years, suggested that we visit a Disciples church.

I didn't know anything about the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ), so I visited the Disciples website (www.disciples.org) to learn a little about the denomination. I appreciated the Disciples passion for freedom of belief, deep Christian spirituality, peace, and justice, and I liked their practice of Baptism by immersion and weekly celebration of the Lord's Supper, so I looked to see if there was a Disciples church within driving distance of our new home.

We found one (less than a mile away!), so the next



Sunday Laurie and I attended our first Disciples worship service at Tropical Sands Christian Church (DOC). (I know that *Tropical Sands* sounds more like the name of a casino or nightclub, but I assure you it was (and still is) a faithful and thriving Disciples congregation!)

Both Jim Burton, the senior pastor, and Joel Tucker, the associate pastor, were spending a long weekend at their *Kyros* prison ministry, so there was a guest minister in the pulpit. An elder explained to us that both pastors were "in jail" that weekend—an interesting introduction to the pastors of Tropical Sands!

That night, Tropical Sands hosted its monthly program of old-time Gospel music called *The Back Door*. Although he was exhausted from a grueling three days of prison ministry, Jim attended the pro-

gram and spent time getting to know Laurie and me.

I was impressed with Jim's dedication and his genuine interest in us as individuals. He didn't focus on trying to convince us to join Tropical Sands or to ascertain our specific beliefs about religion. Jim's active presence at the event despite his weariness and his sincere desire to get to know us as real people—not just as potential members of the church—made us like and respect him immediately.

When Jim visited us at our home for the first time, Jim spoke very openly and honestly about his own beliefs, life, and ministry and listened with genuine interest as Laurie and I talked about our backgrounds and hopes for the future. Impressed with Jim's faith and kindness, Laurie and I began attending Tropical Sands regularly and joined the church a few months later.

We were so blessed and transformed by our experiences at Tropical Sands, that
